(1) Genesis does not mention the Paratime Police nor the concept of paratemporal transposition but it does describe the attempted colonization of Terra by ancient Martians mentioned as the origin of First Level civilization in the Paratime yarns "Last Enemy" and "Time Crime," the only two Paratime yarns to mention specifically the Martian origin of First Level civilization. (When Piper describes the origins of the different levels of Paratime in the novel *Lord Kalvan of Otherwhen*, his final Paratime yarn, he speaks only of "probabilities" and never mentions a Martian origin of Paratime civilization.)

(2) While "Crossroads of Destiny" does not mention the Paratime Police nor the concept of paratemporal transposition it is clearly a story about an interloper from a parallel timeline.

(3) While "The Edge of the Knife" is set slightly in the future from the time it was written its "future" elements, other than the moon program unfolding in the background, are the "future memories" its protagonist has of what is the Terro-human Future History.
